2. Comply with the TSA's program for proof of US citizenship by simply bringing us a valid US passport or a US driver's license and birth certificate.
3. Buy your books and materials and begin your training!
4. Obtain a Student Pilot Certificate from an Aviation Medical Examiner.



FAA GENERAL REQUIREMENTS FOR A PRIVATE PILOT'S LICENSE

IN ORDER TO GET YOUR PRIVATE PILOT'S LICENSE YOU MUST OBTAIN A STUDENT PILOT CERTIFICATE AND A MEDICAL CERTIFICATE FROM AN FAA-DESIGNATED DOCTOR.

YOU MUST BE AT LEAST 16 YEARS OLD IN ORDER TO SOLO IN THE AIRPLANE AND 17 TO OBTAIN YOUR LICENSE.

YOU MUST PASS AN FAA WRITTEN AND PRACTICAL TEST. ALL FAA TESTS ARE ADMINISTERED AT FAA-DESIGNATED COMPUTER TESTING CENTERS. NORTHAMPTON AERONAUTICS IS AN APPROVED TESTING CENTER, SO YOU CAN TAKE ALL YOUR FAA WRITTEN TESTS WITH US!



FAA TRAINING REQUIREMENTS

Under Part 61 of the FAA Federal Aviation Regulations, you must receive a total of 40 hours of flight time which includes 20 hours of training from a certified flight instructor and 10 hours of solo flight time in an airplane.

If you are interested in a career track in aviation, you can accomplish those ratings by enrolling in our FAA-certified Part 141 training.
